



ON-THE-SPOT POSTER MAKING CONTEST GUIDELINES

MECHANICS

1. The contest is open to **all Junior and Senior High School students** enrolled in any schools/institutions in the Philippines. Joining the contest will be **free of charge**.
2. Registration starts at **8:00 AM** while the awarding starts at **2:00 PM**. The student's **school ID must be presented** upon registration.
3. The poster must illustrate, interpret, and emphasize the theme which will revolve around *urban farming*. **The specific theme will be announced on the day of the contest.**
4. The posters will be drawn on a $\frac{1}{8}$ **illustration board**. The board, as well as coloring materials will be provided at the venue. Participants can also bring their own choice of coloring media.
5. Participants will be given **one (1) hour and thirty (30) minutes** to complete their posters. The participants will be held accountable for any issues that may arise with regards to the originality and authenticity of the design.

CRITERIA

The criteria for judging will be as follows:

Creativity and Presentation	40%
Originality	30%
Relevance to the theme	30%

PRIZES

At the end of the program, the top three (3) posters will be awarded with the following:

First place: Php 5,000 + Certificate + Token

Second place: Php 3,000 + Certificate + Token

Third place: Php 1,500 + Certificate + Token

The winning posters will also be framed and displayed at the lobby of the new **Endemic Species Building** in the **University of the Philippines Diliman**. The SPICE Project 3 will also have copyright and exclusive use to publish online, reproduce, distribute, display, and create derivative works of the winning entries for the project's activities without further compensation to the artists.
